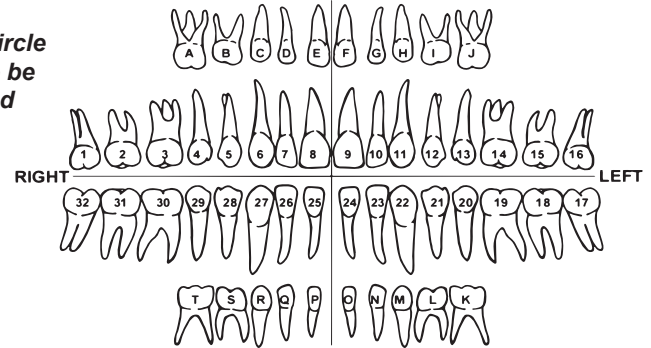

- Certain health conditions may require special preparation before surgery. A history of asthma, heart problems, or high blood pressure plus the use of any blood thinning medication or the appetite suppressant drugs “fenfluramine,” “dexphenfluramine” or “phentermine” are of particular concern. If you have any of these conditions, you need to call our office for a possible pre-surgical evaluation.
- Anyone considering sedation for their surgery will first be scheduled for a consultation appointment. During this appointment, we will review your health history and assess your current health status as well as go over pre-operative instructions and insurance and financial concerns with you.
 - Do not ignore a head or chest cold. Call us if you are suffering from these symptoms because your surgery may need to be rescheduled.
 - If you wear contact lenses, please do not wear them on the day of your surgical procedure.
 - Any unmarried patient under eighteen years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at the time of examination and surgery.

***If You Are Going To Have IV Sedation
Please Follow These Additional Instructions***

- If you are scheduled for IV Sedation, please do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery. If you are scheduled for an IV after 1 p.m., do not eat or drink anything after 7 a.m. This includes candy, gum, mints, or water. For your own safety, your stomach must be completely empty to have IV Sedation.
- Wear low-heeled, comfortable shoes and a short sleeved shirt.
- An adult must accompany you, remain in our office during your treatment, and drive you home after surgery. Do not plan to drive a vehicle for twenty-four hours following surgery.
